Minutes: The motion was made, seconded and unanimous vote to waive the reading and accept the minutes for the 7/8/2025 meeting as previously emailed to all officers and board of directors.

President's Report: Dave reported that nominations for four board positions, President, Treasurer and Secretary will be accepted during the months of September, October and November with voting at the December meeting. El Dorado County Sheriff's deputies will be installing the new shoot house next Tuesday, August 19th.

Vice President & Senior Range Manager Report (SRM): Bob reported the following from Mike Hampton, Lower Range Manager: The calendar continues to be busy, with five dedicated match days per month, 61 sessions during the past month, not including Sheriff and Cal ISO days, and a noted uptick in rifle shooters. We have a very active club which can't run as well as it does without all our devoted volunteers. We continue to attract new members, partly through the matches and partly through walk-ins. The inventory is in good shape, and water is a very popular item during the hot weather. Except for a band-aid here and there, there were no reportable incidents.

Secretary's Report: All new members that apply for membership on or after September 1, 2025, their membership will expire on December 31, 2026, giving them four extra months on the membership

Trap Range RM: Bart reported that it has been slow at the Trap Range mainly because of the hot weather. The trap machines are working well in the heat.

Old Business: None currently.

New Business: The motion was made, seconded and unanimous vote to give Dave L \$600 to purchase six steel plates for the plate rack.

Dave L made us aware of an excellent opportunity for the Club to host a very popular Glock Sport Shooting Foundation (GSSF) match, but we would need another plate rack. After much discussion about the pros and cons of different plate racks, the motion was made, seconded and unanimous vote for Dave L to purchase the plate rack with a trailer not to exceed \$5500.

Member Amer Sahtout shared an offer from the owner of a heavy equipment rental company to provide, deliver and pick up equipment at no charge for the rifle range re-design project. The Club would be responsible for costs such as fuel, operator wages, Worker's Comp Insurance, fuel transport to the range, a water truck, and related needs.

When asked if he would be willing to lead the project, Amer declined and clarified that he did not wish to serve on the Club's Board but emphasized that he wanted to bring the opportunity forward for the Club to consider.

After an extended discussion, Nick volunteered to create a schematic PowerPoint presentation—based on the ideas shared during the meeting and necessary assumptions—for review at a future meeting.
