President's Report: Dave reported that the new plate rack has been ordered and will be delivered to West Sacramento. Dave and Roy Dickinson will be picking it up. The El Dorado County Sheriff's deputies have installed the new shoot house.

Vice President & Senior Range Manager Report (SRM): Bob reported the following from Mike Hampton: The Club hosted 81 sessions during the past month, not including Sheriff and Cal ISO days. However, there was a self-imposed gunshot wound at the True Sportsman Club in Jackson wherein the shooter touched the trigger while holstering and pushed a bullet inside his leg all the way to the ankle. This incident has heightened our awareness that tourniquets and other medical supplies should be carried by, or be within a few feet of the RSO/RO. The Connex is too far away in the event of a significant bleed.
